This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Beaver Valley Sorts Timber Sale #100663 and Forest Practice Application #2616904 proposal consists of four variable retention harvest units and one associated right-of-way totaling 131.4 net harvestable acres, removing approximately 7,286 MBF. The proposal includes 6,960 feet of required road construction, 690 feet of optional road construction, 920 feet of required reconstruction, and 16,265 feet of pre-haul maintenance. Located in Sections 07, 28, 29, 33, Township 28 North, Range 01 East, W.M., Jefferson County.
